

ISOM Honors Hugh Riordan, M.D.

Pioneering Kansas's physician, and the Wichita health facility that he leads, were jointly honored at a recent international medical conference held in Vancouver B.C. April 11-14, 2002.

Hugh Desaix Riordan, M.D., Wichita, Kansas, USA, was named the "Orthomolecular Physician of the Year" at the annual meeting of The International Society for Orthomolecular Medicine (ISOM). Dr. Riordan also accepted the award for "World Leadership in Orthomolecular Medicine," presented to The Center for the Improvement of Human Functioning International, Inc. The Center's Wichita facility, which is known as The Bright Spot for Health, received the award for "its 27 years of outstanding work in the field of Orthomolecular based clinical, educational and research service to the benefit of humankind."
